- The player with the most cards at the end wins








CATCHPHRASE

- The team with the most points wins







CALL SHEET

for 3-5 players



















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RULES

- 1 Players each receive a different bingo sheet.
- Choose one player to be the caller. The caller receives a sheet also.
- The caller's sheet is cut into cards and the cards are placed in a container.
- 4 The caller pulls the cards out of the container one at a time and calls out the item on the card.
- Players mark off the item on their bingo sheet by using a marker or placing a token (the centre square is a free space which all players can mark off at the beginning).
- The first player to mark off five items in a row either horizontally, vertically or diagonally and yell "BINGO" wins.



















































































































- ► Have an adult help you cut out the cards above




